

Three Basic Principles Inside Adversities

1. Gratitude - If we thank Him for the adversity and opportunity to grow, we remain spiritually focused

2. Overcome/Transend – If we remain spiritually focused we will have the strength to overcome our adversities

3. Steadfast in Christ – If we remain steadfast in Christ, heaven will provide solutions, answers to our adversities










Everything We Endure In This Life Is For Our Benefit

- He was in perils with robbers, heathen and false brethren. He suffered weariness, painfulness, hunger and thirst, cold and nakedness


"For our *light affliction*, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory" - 2Cor. 4:17-18
